

Is our Portable Rock Wall Appropriate for Your Event?

Our portable rock wall and attending staff person provides an educational, friendly, supportive environment. Yes, we can bring our portable rock wall to you if:

1. We do not have to set up on grass; no overhead barriers: phone, electrical or limbs.
2. You have large cement or asphalt parking area with no cars nearby that does not have electrical or phone lines or tree limbs.
3. Our wall is 35 feet long including trailer, van and needs a 22 foot diameter circle when set up. On the trailer, while transporting, it is 12 feet high and 12 feet high and 35 feet long. While going up it requires 26 feet high arc coming off our trailer with hydraulic system. The wall rests at 23 feet high.
4. For our discounted price you need to be within 20 min or 15 miles from our site. There will be extra charge if you need us to drive further.
5. You agree to have three to five volunteers to assist children in and out of harnesses, helmets and to collect waivers, etc. OR there is additional charge. **Sign our contract!**
6. We can list your school as an additional insured on our \$2 million aggregate liability insurance policy for small extra charge (\$50).
7. Up to 400 children have climbed on our TWO STATIONS during a school day when school had lots of focused, responsible volunteers (who did not change often requiring us to do repeat training).
8. We need mother or father to sign and complete OUR waiver or child cannot climb.
9. Our fee is non-refundable. We are there in wind, rain, cold, snow, mud, and wet conditions. The wall is climbable in all of these conditions.

These are some of our concerns or parameters for bringing out the wall to you. In some instances, we actually drive out to check out site before agreeing to a venture, although sometimes we have to trust the inspection done by school contact person and are not able to come out in advance.
