We are interviewing campers and leaders in training for our new Adventure Camp. We will be providing the following: exciting, ever-changing sets of adventures, field trips, themes, skills, games, tie-dye shirt designs, team building exercises, leadership roles, badges, scavenger hunts, Wii Fitness, arts and crafts, sports and lots more.

Our camp is educational and not, primarily, a child-care facility. We are seeking campers who are enthusiastic, cooperative, positive and eager to learn new skills and try new adventures! We will be extra structured this summer and key, interesting events and skill sessions will be planned in advance.

Our camp starts at 8 am and ends at 5 pm, M-F. Name games, bonding activities, traversing and skill exercises and climbing are planned for the beginning of each day. Late arrivals may mean your child will miss valuable activities that will help him or her better fit into and enjoy the day and week. Picking up your child early may result in the same outcome.

We want our campers to contribute, try their best....we are not a boot camp...we will ask and encourage participants to try new adventures and activities. Bored, unhappy, unwilling, disruptive, rude campers can detract from the learning and outcomes we promise. We need parents and campers to agree to be "above the line" and demonstrate the following behaviors: being positive, pro-active, cooperative, flexible, participating and ultimately good team members. If your child is not willing to participate or is disruptive...we expect to be able to reach a parent or legal guardian to immediately address this situation. Late arrivals or early pick up may mean your child may miss a valuable field trip, swimming , climbing or other activity. We reserve the right to switch dates and times of any activity for weather, scheduling or other reasons. There will be no refunds or transfers for campers who are not willing to participate, are unhappy with camp, are rude or disruptive or for any other reason that impacts the safety or quality of the camp experience for anyone.
