**June 27<sup>th</sup>-30<sup>th</sup>, 2011**

**WHO:** wounded Combat Veterans, All Veterans, Families, and Friends.

**WHAT:** Four days of outdoor adventure including camping, hiking, rock climbing, white water rafting, and fishing plus some relaxation in hot springs and a visit to the local ghost town.

**WHY:** Explore the outdoors, many adventures and new friends. Participate in fun/playful educational activities for self knowledge, improving communication skills, and enhancing relationships.

**HOW:** Complete Application, Medical, Liability, waiver Forms and talk directly with Trip Leader: Kent Winchester.

**WHEN:** Monday, June 27<sup>th</sup> through Thursday, June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2011

**WHERE:** Winfield, Colorado

Between Leadville and Buena Vista, Colorado

**COST:** \$50/person for Transportation from Denver Airport to Winfield Base camp and back to Airport.

\$50/person for Basic Plan including: camping, cabin use, simple camp food, hiking, general site seeing, fishing and educational/other supplies and materials.

\$100/person (optional) to include white water rafting, wet suit, rock climbing, ALL Guides, equipment and hot springs.

**FACILITATORS:** Kent Winchester, owner of Shared Adventures Inc., a Travel Agency and Training Company, and RockVentures LLC, an Indoor Rock Climbing and Teambuilding Facility. Kent chose early retirement as a Tenured, Senior Faculty member at Rochester Institute of Technology and the National Technical Institute for the Deaf. At RIT, he taught Leadership Training, Human Development and Adapted Physical Education. Kent founded the RIT Red Barn Leadership Training Program, Swain Ski Area Program which includes people with disabilities. Kent has consulted and facilitated Personal and Professional growth seminars nationally and internationally. After facilitating a successful Combat Veterans Adventure weekend in the Adirondacks last summer, Kent is now offering a four-day Adventure in Colorado. Kent has led numerous trips to this region with students from Rochester Institute of Technology and the National Technical Institute for the Deaf. Kent will make all the arrangements, hire certified and insured guides for all events, and even recommend scholarship sources.

Other Certified Event Guides will be joining the trip to assist with rock climbing, and white water rafting. They will provide all necessary equipment and safety instruction. Local residents will provide assistance with fishing, hiking, and sharing the local ghost towns history.
